

Financial Advisors, Calgary

There are currently two Financial Advisor opportunities within the Planning and Analysis department. Both positions report to a Supervisor, Financial Analysis. These positions ensure projects and new business initiatives are developed in accordance with corporate policies. In addition, the Advisors support existing assets: providing toll forecasts, commercial discussions, etc. and are responsible for developing and communicating corporate financial standards as well as reviewing operating division plans and strategies to ensure reasonability and consistency with corporate strategies.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Reviews and develops comprehensive financial models of business development initiatives including fully integrated financial statements and consolidation impacts
- Ensures utilization of standardized valuation methodology to permit inter-project comparisons.
- Identifies and incorporates into financial models the appropriate tax, financing, accounting and legal considerations including supporting memoranda opinions.
- Reviews financial, economic and other key inputs provided by project stakeholders to ensure they are based on realistic and consistent assumptions. Identifies potential areas of risk and suggests risk mitigants.
- Critically examines existing corporate and operating division strategies and ensures the alignment of new projects and business development initiatives with the overall corporate strategy.
- Provides assistance in drafting Board of Directors memoranda and develop presentation material for management.
- Develops and makes presentations on various projects and issues.
- Directs and reviews the work of other staff in the area and coaches them on the skills and knowledge required in the department.
- Interacts effectively with personnel across the organization and externally.
- Provides ongoing commercial/regulatory support (toll forecasts, strategy analyses, etc.)

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Business education from a nationally recognized program (B.Comm or similar. An MBA and/or CA, CMA, CFA are desirable).
- A minimum of 5 years of relevant experience.
- Strong analytical communication and interpersonal skills.
- Financial modeling skills and understanding of accounting, tax, financing, and legal issues.
- Able to work independently under broad direction.

- Demonstrate initiative and creativity in developing innovative approaches and solutions to business issues.
