Reporting to the Director, Analytics and Optimization, the Water Asset Specialist is responsible for the optimization of water plants. Working in conjunction with water operations, the asset specialist provides commercial, analytical and financial expertise in the strategic management of EPCOR Alberta's commercial water assets. The position is responsible for acting as the main point of contact for EA commercial matters associated with the assigned assets, acting as the primary source of commercial and contractual expertise associated with the assets, identifying and/or analyzing the variety of issues and opportunities for the current or future operation of the assets and assuming overall short and long-term strategic direction associated with the assets.

Specific responsibilities include:

- Maintaining and developing business expert knowledge of all contracts and agreements associated with the assets;
- Ensuring commercial compliance is maintained with all agreements and contracts;
- Managing all issues, disputes, etc. associated with the assets, in coordination with operations, internal and external stakeholders, and subject matter experts;
- Acting as a representative on applicable Operating or Owner Committees;
- Maintaining and updating annually, or as required, Asset Management Plans;
- Assistance with the preparation and monitoring of budgets and short- and long-term forecasts;
- Developing and monitoring key financial and operational metrics to ensure the effective management of the assets;
- Monitoring, identifying and analyzing issues and opportunities related to the current or future operation of the assets and recommend and lead efforts to resolve them in coordination with internal or external experts as required; and
- Lead projects and initiatives applicable to asset management matters as assigned.

The successful candidate has completed an undergraduate degree in Engineering, Business or Commerce and has a minimum of 4 - 6 years experience in an operational, commercial, engineering, business development, or financial role within the commercial water or related industry. A related post-graduate degree and CFA designation would be considered an asset. Familiarity with commercial water market, water and waste water treatment plants or similar plant operations is desired along with experience developing and applying complex multi-year legal agreements/contracts. You are an effective communicator with the ability to excel in a dynamic, fast paced and multi-disciplinary project team environment. You must have strong inter-personal skills for managing and maintaining internal and external customer relationships. A strong sense of initiative and an ability to work well independently, strong attention to detail and accuracy, and problem solving skills are essential.
